### INTENT TO ENROLL INFORMATION AND APPLICATION



#### APPLYING FOR JOINT ADMISSION:

This form is to be completed by Manchester Community College students earning a minimum of 2.0 cumulative grade point average, and a minimum of 24 semester credits prior to enrolling at Bay Path College. Students seeking joint admission into specialized programs, including, but not limited to, occupational therapy, and forensic science, must satisfy all program requirements and earn the minimum cumulative grade point average established for those programs.

1. *When do I submit this form?* You are encouraged to send your forms early. In a given year, some majors may be especially popular and reach their maximum enrollment early.
2. *Where should I send this form?* Once you complete each item on this form, send it to: Office of Transfer Admissions, Bay Path College, 588 Longmeadow Street, Longmeadow, MA 01106
3. *Is there anything else I need to do?* Immediately request an official copy of your academic transcript from the registrar's office at Manchester Community College and send it to Bay Path College admissions office. Once you have finished your last semester at Manchester Community College, please request another official transcript that shows you have graduated and forward it to the BPC admissions office.

#### OTHER ENROLLMENT INFORMATION:

- You should contact BPC to determine whether more information is required to complete your application process.
- If you were previously enrolled at BPC, you are NOT eligible for joint admission.
- If you have attended another college since completing your degree, you are not eligible for joint admission and should submit a BPC application for admission.
