You must file a federal income tax return if you are a citizen or resident of the United States or a resident of Puerto Rico and you meet the filing requirements for any of the following categories that apply to you.

### Filing Requirements for Most Taxpayers

\*Gross income means all income you received in the form of money, goods, property and services that is not exempt from tax, including any income from sources outside the United States (even if you may exclude part or all of it). **Do not** include social security benefits as gross income unless you are married filing a separate return and you lived with your spouse at any time during 2013.

Per IRS requirements, you must file federal taxes if *gross income is:	
Single	\$ 9,500 or more
Head of Household	\$12,200 or more
Married, filing jointly	\$19,000 or more
Married, filing separately	\$ 3,700 or more

### Filing Requirements for Dependents

If your parents (or someone else) can claim you as a dependent, use this table to see if you must file a return. In this table, earned income includes salaries, wages, tips and professional fees. It also includes taxable scholarship and fellowship grants. Unearned income includes investment-type income, unemployment compensation, taxable social security benefits, pensions, annuities, debt cancellation and distributions of unearned income from a trust. Gross income is the total of your earned and unearned income.

Per IRS requirements, you must file federal taxes if any of the following apply:	
Unearned Income	\$ 2,500 or more
Earned Income	\$ 7,600 or more
Gross Income was more than the larger of	\$ 2,500 or your earned income plus \$1850

\$	\$	<u>Child support received</u> for all children. Don't include foster care or adoption payments.
\$	\$	Housing, food and other living allowances paid to members of the military, clergy and others including cash payments and cash value of benefits.
\$	\$	<u>Veterans' noneducation benefits</u> such as Disability, Death Pension or Dependency & Indemnity Compensation (DIC) and/or VA Educational work-study allowances.
\$	\$	Any other untaxed income or benefits not reported elsewhere such as workers' compensation, untaxed portions of railroad retirement benefits, disability, etc.
\$	\$	Money received or paid on your behalf (e.g. bills), not reported elsewhere on this form.
